CSI Houston Chapter Meeting

Principles of Sustainable Design for Commercial Buildings

John Sanchez and Chris Jones, with CertainTeed will take an extensive look at the principals behind designing commercial buildings with an emphasis on efficiency and sustainability through implementation of systems that are durable and easy to maintain for the January CSI Houston Chapter meeting.

The basics of integrated design is also discussed, explaining why integrated design is such a critical part of how efficient sustainable buildings are designed and built on time and within budget.

To provide insight into design methods, the presentation compares aspects of sustainable and standard design features for critical systems. To provide guidance for renovation projects the presentation discusses energy audits, indoor air quality, and maintenance issues.

John Sanchez is the territory manager for central and south Texas. His focus is on establishing relationships with suppliers and contractors.

Chris Jones, CSI, IIDA, LEED AP, HERS, IECC, was a founding board member of Green Built Texas and currently chairs the USGBC Texas Gulf Coast Advocacy committee and serves on the USGBC Green Schools committee.
